- ❖ Points will not count until nomination form is received. You do not have to belong to a club or association to participate!
- ❖ Must nominate in category to qualify for year end awards;
- ❖ The more you participate, the more your points you earn towards awards.
- ❖ An affiliated show is one judge, which equals one show (per class shown). For instance: if a show runs the same class on two different days with 2 different judges this is considered 2 shows; If a show is double judged, this is considered 2 shows; If a show has a judge in the main ring, and another judging trail, this is considered one show.
- ❖ **For 2024, Must show in 2 shows to qualify for Year End Award.**
- ❖ Points kept on equine except where indicated.
- ❖ Points will be awarded 7-5-4-3-2-1 for 6 entries in a class. The first place horse gets an extra point. If 5 entries in a class the points will be as follows 6-4-3-2-1; refer to rule book for point chart.

Points for Performance on the Horse/ Equitation is on the Exhibitor

_____ Western Performance Horse/Pony	All western under saddle classes count- such as pleasure, road hack, bosal, command, discipline rail, reining, western riding, stock horse, trail, age specific/open western classes
_____ Ranch Performance/Equitation	All 'Ranch' specific classes including In Hand, Ranch Pleasure, Ranch Equitation, Ranch Trail, Ranch Pattern, etc.
_____ Western Equitation	Western Equitation Classes to count (points on rider only)
_____ English Performance Horse/Pony	All English under saddle classes count- such as pleasure, road hack, hunter on the flat, command, discipline rail, trail, age specific/open hunter, hunt seat, and English classes
_____ English Equitation	English Equitation Classes to count (points on rider only)
_____ Liberty	Open to horses/ponies/miniature horses
_____ Solid Color Horse/Pony/Mini	All Solid Color Classes open to horses/ponies/minis
_____ Multi Color Horse/Pony/Mini	All Multi-Color Classes open to horses/ponies/minis
_____ Starter Horse/Pony (2-gaited)	All Starter horse/pony classes. This is a 2-gait division, and may cross enter into other WT Classes
_____ Green Horse/Pony	All classes specifying Green - in hand, pleasure, equitation, etc.
_____ Jack Benny 39 & Over	All Jack Benny classes (both 2 & 3 gaited classes count)
_____ Pony Performance	All classes open to ponies - pleasure, equitation, road hack, command, disciplined rail, over fences, trail
_____ Very Small Equine Performance	Very Small Equine- all equines 11.2 hands & Under including ponies and miniature horses; obstacle in hand, hunter, jumper
_____ Driving Very Small Equine	All driving classes- pleasure driving, country pleasure driving, obstacle, quadrangles, reinsmanship
_____ Driving Horse/Pony over 11.2 hands	Any WT Cross Rail classes including WT Cross Rail Hunter Hack may NOT cross enter into any other O/F class, includes Cross Rails
_____ Walk/Trot Cross Rails	All Over Fence Classes that are Straight Rail Classes including Hunter Hack, can not cross enter into judged Cross Rail Classes
_____ Hunter Over Fence -Straight Rails	All O/F classes that are Cross Rail Classes including Hunter Hack Cross Rail, cannot cross enter judged Straight Rail Classes
_____ Hunter Over Fence Cross Rails	All seats, all Leadline u/s classes count except Leadline Gymkhana
_____ Leadline Riders 3-8yrs	All walk/trot age specific & open WT classes
_____ Walk/Trot Rider 13 yrs & Over (All Seats)	All walk/trot age specific & open WT classes
_____ Walk/Trot Rider 12 yrs & under Western	All walk/trot age specific & open WT classes
_____ Walk/Trot Rider 12 yrs & under English	All walk/trot age specific & open WT classes

<i>Walk/Trot Riders may not cross enter into 3-gaited classes</i>

_____ Also offered **Saddle Up For Sunshine Trail Riding Program** (which runs from October 1st thru September 30th)
