****** RULES AND REGULATIONS****

- 1. PROOF OF CURRENT COGGINS AND RABIES VACCINATIONS FOR EACH ANIMAL MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE SHOW OFFICE WHEN MAKING ENTRIES- NO EXCEPTIONS
- 2. FOR PRE ENTRIES PLEASE SEND YOUR ENTRIES with all the classes you want to enter. No worries if you can't make it, no money down needed. When you arrive please leave a blank check at the office. Pre-Entries MUST POSTMARKED by June 2nd-NO EXCEPTIONS. \$10.00 LATE FEE if you do NOT pre-enter. All classes to be paid for as entered or a blank check left at the show office. Please enter at least THREE classes in advance. You must scratch THREE classes in advance or you will be charged for the class. **Must enter at least 3 classes in the division to be eligible for day end awards of Grand Champion and Reserve*
- 3. There is a \$5.00 office fee per number. One number will be assigned to each exhibitor/horse combination
- 4. The show will run in accordance with Sunshine Show Series rules. See Sunshine Horse Show Series Rule Book go to www.ssshowseries.com It is the entrant's responsibility to know all the rules pertaining to their classes and enter the correct classes. Nominate yourself and your horse for the Sunshine Horse Show Series Awards. Go the www.ssshowseries.com for a nomination form and mail it in or hand in before the show starts.
- 5. Any non showing horses on the grounds must show proof of coggins and rabies to the show office. If stalled the owner must come and register for a stall at the show office. If not stabled a \$5.00 unstabled fee applies.
- 6. Stalls available Friday after 3:00 PM at \$25.00 per stall- ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS- There is a one time \$5.00 un-stabled horse fee. You must post the index card the Club provides on your stall door. * ABSOLUTELY NO ARRIVALS BEFORE 3pm, THIS IS A FAIRGROUNDS RULE! EARLY ARRIVALS WILL BE CHARGED \$150 BY THE FAIRGROUNDS!! *If you are found without your tag you will be charged double. If you are found without a camper tag you will be charged double. You must display a camper tag in your camper window.
- 7. Horses MUST be at the gate prior to the start of the class. There will be a 3 minute limit for tack changes and they must be made at the gate.
- 8. Show management reserves the right to combine and cancel classes.
- 9. All riders 17 years of age and under or competing in 17 & under classes must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) Equestrian Standard per NY State Law No. VAT1265.
- 10. <u>Starter Classes</u> are for horses/ponies that do not canter and may not enter any canter classes at any competition or exhibition. Horses/ponies may enter this division for as long as they do not canter or lope at any competition or exhibition.
- 11. Any horse/rider combination showing walk/trot or jog classes may not cross enter into classes requiring a canter or lope with the exception of Jack Benny classes and the special benefit "open to all" classes
- 12. ***Hunter Divisions*** new for 2025*** rules. Year end points in these classes are on the horse. Must enter the over fences portion of the division to be eligible to enter the under saddle class. Horses in the crossrail, 2' and 2'3" hunter divisions may show and nominate for the year in two consecutive divisions. Either crossrail and 2' hunter OR 2' and 2'3 hunter. Walk/trot hunter over ground poles is open to any horse/rider combination who has never shown at the canter. ***Schooling over fences is allowed Friday evening after the course is set and Saturday morning until ten minutes before the start of the show.
- *Classes 43, 44, 62 and 63 are open to all horses and ponies and riders of all ages, regardless of showing at a canter in other classes. Proceeds from classes 43 and 44 will go to the Sandi Emanuel Junior Award. This will be a day end monetary award to help with show expenses to a junior rider based on show performance, attitude and sportsmanship. The winner will be selected by the judge and show committee. Proceeds from Class 62 will go to the Schoharie County Animal Shelter in honor of our long time members Virginia Terk, who we lost in 2022 and Connie Sondergaard, who we lost in 2020. Proceeds from class 63 will go to The Bruce Emanuel Scholarship fund.
